The income that the Hundred Club receives will be distributed between the prize fund and Cricket Club development on a 50:50 basis.

Naturally the prizes are dependent on the number of members. For example if 75 people join the Hundred Club the monthly prize fund would be £150 distributed as follows:

1 st prize	£75
2 nd prize	£30
3 rd prize	£15
Accumulator	£30

Bramhall Cricket Hundred Club

Rules

1. The aim and objectives of the Bramhall Cricket Hundred Club (**the Hundred Club**) are to distribute prizes to members of Bramhall Cricket Club (BCC) and to raise funds for the benefit of the said Club.
2. People entitled to join the Hundred Club are the members of Bramhall Cricket Club and any other person provided that in both cases they have attained the age of 18.
3. The secretary and treasurer of the Hundred Club are Jenny Rickson and Barry Rickson respectively.
4. Each member of the Hundred Club shall pay £4.00 per month (**the stake**) by bankers order collected on the 10th of each month. Members shall be assigned a membership number.
5. Members who fail to pay the monthly stake will be automatically disqualified from taking part in the prize draw.
6. If a member no longer wishes to belong to the Hundred Club he or she shall notify the secretary in writing, cancel their standing order and his or her number will be re-allocated to another person
7. Stake money collected from the bank accounts of members shall be held in a designated account of Bramhall Cricket Club.
8. Stake money received will be distributed between prize money (**the prize fund**) and Club funds on a 50:50 basis.
9. The monthly prizes shall be drawn at the Clubhouse by the Chairman of BCC or his nominated representative at 9.00pm on the last Friday in each month except in December. Stake money paid in December will form part of the prize fund for the draw to be held in January. The results of each draw will be posted on the Club's website by the Wednesday of the following week.
10. The prize fund is dependent on the number of members of the Hundred Club. The monthly prize fund will be apportioned as follows:

1 st prize	50% of the said fund
2 nd prize	20%
3 rd prize	10%
The accumulator (As defined below)	20%
11. There shall be a monthly accumulator prize (**the accumulator**). The accumulator shall be won if the member holding the number drawn is present at the Club to claim the prize. If the prize isn't claimed on the night of the draw it shall be carried forward to the next draw and added to the accumulator on that occasion. The accumulator will continue to be carried forward until won as described above.
12. The Hundred Club's annual accounting period shall be 1st October – 30th September. At the end of each period the Treasurer will prepare accounts detailing income, prize distribution and the allocation to Bramhall Cricket Club funds.
